DAY LETTER

PROFESSOR MACLAURIN,
593 STATE WAR & NAVY BLDG.,
WASHINGTON, D.C.

Am greatly disturbed over orders from Washington which last week took away
and
60 men to officers training camp at Fort Lee, To-day 107 men in the Field
Artillery and Aviation. We had a distinct understanding with your Committee
that no students would be taken away until the 1st of January. If this policy
is continued it will render all academic work absolutely futile. Hope you can
plan some relief. Kindly let me know at your earliest convenience decision
regarding request made in my telegram to you on Sunday, to fill up our training
corps quota.
