

BOARD CLOSES SCHOOLS

The Board of Education on Tuesday morning of this week received the following letter from the Borough Health Officer.

To the Board of Education,

Owing to the presence of Epidemic Influenza in Princeton and vicinity, the Board of Health recommends that all schools be closed immediately and until further notice.

It is hoped by taking this action we will prevent the disease from spreading through our community as it has in others, and that the schools will be permitted to reopen in the near future.
