

THEATRICAL AND LIQUOR PEOPLE SEEK RELIEF FROM QUARANTINE

(By Associated Press.)

Harrisburg, Pa., Oct. 9—Delegations of theatrical managers and wholesale liquor dealers, who called upon commissioner of Health Royer today were informed that there was no date upon which it could be stated that the anti-congregating and saloon closing order would be lifted. Both promised cooperation in carrying out the order and Dr. Royer said that at the earliest possible date notice would be given them of changed conditions.

The theatrical people represented that they were suffering heavy losses and could not arrange future dates. The liquor people asked that the commissioner make some regulation whereby family trade could be cared for. Dr. Royer said that he could promise no relief but agreed to receive and consider a plan which they would present for shipments to residents.
