

EPIDEMIC PASSES

Two Emergency Hospitals Close This Morning, 13 Patients Taken Elsewhere

This morning the two emergency hospitals at the Ethan Allen club house and at the high school will close. This has been made possible by the rapid recovery of the patients and the successful checking of the further spreading of Spanish influenza. These two places will be fumigated for several days before the public is allowed to use them again, the disinfecting to be done under the direction of the local and State boards of health.

Last night there were only 13 patients in the places, with nine at the high school and four at the club house from the former four were taken home during the day and from the latter five. No new patients were admitted to either place. If the 13 patients are unable to be conveyed to their homes to-day they will be removed to the Mary Fletcher hospital.

According to information furnished by the local board of health there were only six new cases reported yesterday and the majority of these were "stragglers," which should have been reported during the last three or four days but which were overlooked by physicians.
