My dear Admiral:-

Have received your letters No. SD-12 7510-D12 (54) and SD-127510-D12 (52). Both were received after my report was submitted, which Admiral Jayne informs me he forwarded to the Department with his comments on the subject as a whole. The results of the different reports do not materially differ. The comparative statistics forwarded by the Bureau are of the entire Station whereas Admiral Jayne only desired those of the Training Camps in order to obtain effects upon raw recruits.
