

Regular Meeting, December 27, 1918.

Pursuant to call issued December 23, a meeting of the Colorado State Board of Health was held December 27 in the Capitol.

Meeting was called to order at 12:30 P.M. by Dr. Frank R. Coffman, who, upon motion of Dr. Sharpley, was elected temporary chairman.

The Secretary called the roll as follows: Present, Drs. Coffman, Bundsen, Sharpley, Hanson, Kennedy and Mr. Scott.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

The application of Dr. Julia T. Hill Crawford of Denver, to conduct a hospital ("Rest Home") at 1274 Marion Street, was read and discussed. Dr. Sharpley moved that the license be granted. Motion was seconded by Dr. Bundsen and carried.

The application of Mrs. Bessie Davey of Denver, to conduct a hospital ("North Denver General Hospital") at 2417 W. 32nd Ave., Denver, was read and discussed. Dr. Sharpley moved that the license be granted. Motion was seconded by Mr. Scott and carried.

The application of the Fraternal Hospital Association of Colorado to conduct a general hospital at Pueblo was discussed. Dr. Sharpley moved that the license be granted. Motion was seconded by Mr. Scott and carried.

The report of the Medical Inspector was read and approved.

The reports of the Food and Drug Division for the months of October and November were read and approved.

Dr. Lamb's report was received.

The Medical Inspector's report on conditions around San Miguel River, was read and discussed. Dr. Sharpley moved that the matter be referred to the Attorney General.

The Secretary reported that the Mayor and Health Officers of Montrose had requested that instructions as to what means for combating the Influenza epidemic in that city, be wired by the State Board of Health, and that he had promised to ask the Board to formulate the action it would suggest. Dr. Sharpley moved that Dr. Hanson be given full power to take charge of the situation. Motion was seconded by Mr. Scott and carried.

Mr. Scott moved that the bill for licensing of painting and decorating contractors presented by Mr. John

Ronnquist, be laid on the table. Motion was seconded by Dr. Hanson and carried.

There being no further business for consideration, Dr. Sharpley moved that the Board adjourn. Motion seconded by Mr. Scott.
