

QUARANTINE RULES ARE CHANGED SLIGHTLY

At a meeting last night of city and county officials to determine as to the completely raising or not of the general quarantine that has been on over a month, those present were evenly divided in the matter. About one-half of them wanted the town thrown wide open again, and the others opposed it. A compromise was made, however. The ban on travel has been completely raised. One can come and go now at will without

question of any officials of this city or county. Heretofore a 48-hour quarantine maintained.

The free to travel permit will continue for one week when the official body will meet again and determine further action.

Should no danger arise from the free travel permit by next Tuesday. It is probable the quarantine will be lifted completely. Should new cases of influenza develop, the lid will be put on again.
