OBITUARY.

The funeral of Malcomb Parent, son of Mrs. Catherine Comstock, who went August 15 to the mechanical school at Tufts College, Medford, Mass., and who died from Spanish influenza at Elizabeth hospital, Boston, was held at St. Peter's church, Vergennes, last Thursday morning. The Rev. L. A. Vezina officiated. The bearers consisted of a squad from Co. D, First Vermont Regiment, V. V.M., commanded by Sergt. Charles Ruscoe, which also fired a volley at the grave. Burial was beside his father, Frank Parent, in St. Peter's cemetery, Vergennes. He was 21 years of age and besides his mother he is survived by one sister, Miss Florence Parent, and a half brother, John Parent, who is with the American expeditionary forces in France.
