ORDER RELATING TO THE CONTROL OF INFLUENZA.

1. As a precaution against the spread and development of the epidemic of Spanish Influenza, it is hereby ordered that all schools, churches, picture houses, places of public entertainment and all public meeting places be closed and the public assembling of people be forbidden throughout the State of Vermont.

2. Health Officers and local boards of health are directed to promulgate and enforce this order immediately on receipt of notification from the State Board of Health.

3. This order shall remain in effect until vacated by a notice from the Secretary of the State Board of Health.

4. Made and promulgated under authority of the General Laws of Vermont relating to Public Health, this 4th day of October, 1918.
