CLOSING ORDER VACATED NOVEMBER 3, 1918.

Health officers and local boards of health are hereby notified that the order of the State Board of Health dated October 4, 1918, forbidding the opening of schools, churches, picture houses and public entertainments and preventing the public assembling of people will be vacated from midnight of November 2nd. This will allow church services to be held on Sunday, November 3rd, and usual public gatherings thereafter.

Exception is made in communities where local boards of health may consider necessary the continued closing of one or more of the public gatherings indicated in the order. Local boards of health are given authority to regulate such conditions in their own towns.
