

Fifteen men of the Army Service school at Colorado College at Colorado Springs are isolated and under care of medical officers and nurses in the belief that they may have Spanish influenza. The quarters of the entire radio detachment of 200 men are under strict quarantine.

Seventy-five cases of influenza have been reported among the men taking army training at the University of Colorado at Boulder. The doctors in charge state that no case is serious, though some of the men are ill.
