Dear Miss Meng,

As Miss Orlady has written you, I think today, we are entirely willing to have you vaccinated here only it will require you to make three trips to the college before you can be admitted to lectures. It would be well for you to take your first vaccination tomorrow at the College Infirmary on Gulph Road just below the college campus. The doctor is there from 4 to 6. Please do not go into any other college building. The doctor will tell you when to come again. There will be no charge for the vaccinations but the railway fare in and out you will of course have to pay for yourself. After the third vaccination we shall be very glad to have you begin your work at the college and go and come on the trains.
