Dear Miss Thomas;

Owing to Dr. Kingsbury's illness I have not discussed with her the probable expenditure of her department for 1918-19. During 1917-18 the appropriation for her laboratory was \$765.00; this was overexpended by \$600.00 and is charged against her appropriation for 1918-19, which is only \$765.00. Therefore, her appropriation for 1918-19 will be all used in a very short time. If it could be increased by \$600.00 (the amount overexpended in 1917-18) it would enable her to start off in 1918-1919 with her full appropriation and by the end of this year we could determine whether this amount (\$765.00) is the proper amount to allow in the Budget for her laboratory.


The Chemical Laboratory appropriation for 1918-18 was originally \$810.00 and later increased by \$300.00 to meet increased costs of materials owing to the war; thus the appropriation for 1917-18 was actually \$1110.00 and this was overexpended by \$550.00. However, a large part of this overexpenditure will be refunded as the cost of summer work is to be paid by the Government and the Chemical Laboratory Appropriation for 1918-19 of \$900.00 may be sufficient.

The Psychology Appropriation of 1917-18 was overexpended by \$77.00, but since the appropriation of 1918-19 is restored to \$900.00 this may be sufficient for this laboratory.

In 1917-18 and 1918-19 no appropriation is made in the Budget
