

# EPIDEMIC STILL AFFECTING COAL

WASHINGTON, Nov. 10. (A. P.)—

Production of both bituminous and anthracite coal continues to decrease, as the result of the influenza epidemic, and a renewed appeal for conservation by householders and others was issued today by the fuel admin-

During the week ending November 2 the output of bituminous coal was 19,465,000 net tons, a decrease of 3 per cent, compared with the week before, while only 1,500,000 net tons of anthracite was produced, compared with 1,714,000 net tons the previous week.
