Dear Sir:

Receipt is acknowledged of your communication of November 13th enclosing copies of resolutions adopted by the San Francisco Church Federation in relation to the closing of saloons throughout the city, and also copy of your reply thereto. In reference to same I beg to state that at a special meeting of the Board of Health held on Wednesday, November 13, 1918, a resolution was passed which virtually lifts the entire ban from all activities inhibited during the epidemic of Influenza. In view of these circumstances it would appear as if no action would be necessary at this time on said resolution.
