Dear Sir:-

I respectfully desire to advise you that at a meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners, held on the 5th instant, the following resolution, in recognition of the services rendered by members of the San Francisco Fire Department during the recent influenza epidemic, was unanimously adopted by the Board:

RESOLVED; THAT the Board of Fire Commissioners of San Francisco hereby officially places on record its appreciation and thanks to the officers and members of this department who so unselfishly volunteered their services and exposed themselves to the dangers of the recent influenza epidemic in this city, and hereby declares their generous service in that behalf worthy of the highest commendation as the action of men who have deserved well of their city.

RESOLVED; FURTHER, that a duly certified copy of these resolutions be forwarded by the Office Superintendent and Secretary to his Honor, the Mayor, and to the Board of Health of this City and County.
