Sir:-  
Relative to the Influenza situation in the city will state that there is a decrease in the number of cases reported over that of Saturday, and that the Board of Health does not desire to impose a hardship upon the public nor disturb what would be normal condition unless absolutely necessary, and we therefore have agreed to postpone definite action on the masks until Thursday morning, December 12, 1918.
