

300 INFLUENZA CASES AT DUNSMUIR; SIX DEAD

SACRAMENTO, October 11.—There are three hundred cases of Spanish influenza at Dunsmuir. The sixth death occurred today when J. Seriaro, Southern Pacific employe, succumbed. The Town Trustees have closed schools, barber shops, dental offices and motion houses.

"Keep moving." is the order for pedestrians in the business section. "You can't stop and talk with your friends." The city has commenced delivery of groceries to stricken families, as there is no local delivery at Dunsmuir. This keeps members of the families at home. The State Board of Health has ordered nurses sent here. Yreka also sent nurses. Castella, Shasta county, has thirty cases; Kennett twenty and Redding thirty-two.
