

Influenza Shows Little Material Change in State

SACRAMENTO, October 28.—There has been no material change, generally, in the influenza epidemic in California, according to the State Board of Health. Reports received Sunday and today showed the total number of cases since the outbreak of the epidemic had reached a total of 67,350.

Some of the districts in the extreme northern and southern parts of the State showed improved conditions, but this was offset by increased number of cases reported from other parts of the State, it was stated at the Board of Health office.

Representatives of the board reported that its staff for rendering emergency aid in various cities and towns have visited 21 places.

There have been a total of 1611 cases in San Francisco to date with 14 deaths.
