

Mask Arrests Net Money for Mercy

Police Judge Oppenheim sent seven violators of the mask ordinance to jail yesterday for ten days each and five others were fined \$10 each. Thomas McKewen, William Allen, John Ryan, Thomas Osborn and Alberto Blanco were among those to draw jail sentences. Judge Brady imposed \$5 fines on each of those convicted before him of failure to wear a mask. Two hundred dollars was the result and the money is to be given to the Red Cross.

San Franciscans are adapting themselves to the wearing of influenza masks and instances of willful negligence or neglect are disappearing, according to the police records, which show only fifty arrests made for this cause yesterday, as compared with twice that number the day before.
