
Legislator Without Mask Is Arrested

SACRAMENTO, January 19.—California legislators are not to receive the exemption from arrest they have been asserting under the State law at the hands of the Sacramento police. Members of the Legislature refused to wear gauze influenza masks. For a few days the Police Department did not arrest them, but finally Patrolman Redding, in charge of the mask squad, announced that none of the legislators would be given further exemption, and to prove his statement placed under arrest Assemblyman H. B. Ream of Siskiyou county, who was found in a hotel lobby with no mask over mouth and nose.
