

Man Talks Court

Out of 'Mask' Fine

"Professor" Timothy Minott, colored, did \$10 worth of talking before Police Judge Brady yesterday. He would have been fined that amount for not wearing a gauze mask. He told the court that he is a professor of psychology and that the court had better beware of blonde women and wet places and be sure to vote the Republican ticket next week. Judge Brady was so impressed by the speech that he remitted the fine of \$10 and Professor Minott walked out of the court a free man.

In the same court forty other men charged with the same offense were fined \$5 each. The court announced that second offenders will be sent to jail for a period.

Police Judge Oppenheim sentenced the following men to jail for ten days for refusing to wear the masks: Alberto Blanco, Thomas McKewen, William Allen, Thomas Osborn, John Ryan. Several others were fined \$10 each.

More than fifty additional men were arrested yesterday for not wearing masks.
